IT'S CONVENTION TIME!

JUNE 21-25, 2018 IN VICTORIA, VANCOUVER ISLAND, BRITISH COLUMBIA!

This issue contains lots of information about the 2018 Convention in Victoria, Canada which is being hosted by 1st Vice President Katy Prendergast and the Chicago Manx Society. Be sure to reserve your hotel room, book your transport to Victoria island, and if you're not Canadian or American, get your eTA in plenty of time.

Convention times run from the evening Thursday, June $21^{\rm st}$ to the evening of Saturday, June $23^{\rm rd}$.

We encourage everyone to stay at the official NAMA Conference Hotel

As administrators to the conference, NAMA is contractually required to guarantee a level of usage for the Hotel Grand Pacific and holds a financial responsibility to do so. The room rate is good for 3 days either side of the Convention. Ouote NAMA Convention 2018 and reserve by Monday May 22, 2018 to get the group room rate of Can\$249/night, or upgrade to a harbor view for \$40/night.

REMEMBER VISA REQUIRED BY SOME TO TRAVEL TO CANADA

All international travelers must carry acceptable identification and a valid eTA visa (if necessary) when entering Canada. <u>Americans traveling on an American passport do not need an eTA.</u>

FASCINATING SPEAKERS FOR 2018 CONVENTION THE WOOD BROTHERS

Marjorie Cullerne is a violinist/fiddler, a music historian, and has a deep knowledge of her own Manx Heritage (her grandfather, and two of her great-grandparents are buried on the IOM, as are an aunt and uncle but, more importantly for NAMA 2018, she will be sharing her knowledge of two (deceased) Manx musicians, who are as near to famous as it's possible to be from the Isle of Man unless you're a Bee Gee. Marjorie is an expert on the musician brothers Harry Wood and Haydn Wood (shown) - brothers of her grandmother Mary Hannah Cullerne, née Wood.



She and her research partner have created a website about Haydn Wood (1882-1959). www. haydwoodmusic. com. Marjorie will both speak and play at the convention. She is a Victoria, BC, resident.

Manx Gaelic in 30 minutes!

Bill Cassidy introduces the Manx language, Gaelg, a sister tongue of Irish and Scottish Gaelic. Learn a bit about the history of Manx Gaelic and pick up some important phrases. We'll have a braew time and you'll soon have Manx *dy liooar!*

The Isle of Man is home to many creatures of legend from the Buggane to the Tarroo Ushtey. Manx mythological creatures are tied to the landscape like the Mooinjer Veggey with Fairy Bridge and the Moddey Dhoo with Peel Castle. Some are beautiful like the Ben Varrey (mermaids); creepy like the Glashtyn (water demon); or kinda goofy like Jef (he actually has a music video and stars in a web comic). Let's discover more about these unique beings that belong to our unique Isle.

NORTH AMERICAN MANX YOUTH AWARD PRIZE \$200 AND LIFETIME NAMA MEMBERSHIP

Please nominate a young person from your Society to receive this award at the Victoria Convention in June! The award recognizes under 21 year-olds living in North America for their contribution in maintaining an awareness of the Isle of Man and its culture. The prize includes a check for US\$200 and free lifetime membership of the North American Manx Association from NAMA, and an award hewn from Pooil Vaaish marble from the Isle of Man Government.

The winner must demonstrate an interest in Manx culture or history by sharing their knowledge through essay, art, multimedia, performance art, etc. Nominations will be accepted via the internet or by snail mail. Each nomination must be in the form of a short description of the nominee's work that explains how this relates to the Isle of Man.

Photos or video of the original work should accompany the nomination (soft or hard copies). Nominees must provide contact details for themselves and one reference that may be used by the judges to discuss the work and its authenticity. All initial contacts should go to BEEVES@juno.com.
